Education:

Experience:

preference is given to those with homecare or patient care experiences

Other:

preference is given to those with Basic life support BLS and other training.

Fluent in English, has a valid driver's license, has a reliable vehicle, basic computer skills, must be able to read and write

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is required to stand, sit and walk; frequently use hands to finger, handle, or feel, including operation of a standard computer keyboard and other medical office equipment; reach with hands and arms and talk, see, and hear. Eye-hand coordination and manual dexterity are required. The employee must occasionally lift/move up to 25 pounds, bend, stoop, stretch, or crouch. Specific vision abilities required by the job include close vision, color vision, distance vision, and the ability to adjust focus; prolonged visual acuity is required.
